 Certificate No. 804 Whereas Charles Davis of Buffalo County
 Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the
 United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office
 at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full
 payment has been made by the said Charles Davis according
 to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24 of April 1820
 Entituled an act making further provision for the Sale of Public
 Lands for the East half of the South East Quarter the South
 West Quarter of the South East Quarter and the South
 East Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Twenty Eight
 in Township Nine North of Range Thirteen West in the description
 of lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing
 One Hundred and Forty Acres according to the Official plat of the
 Survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by
 the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the
 said Charles Davis Now I know by & that the United States
 of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with its
 several acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and
 granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Charles
 Davis and to his heirs the tract above described to have and to hold
 the same together with all the rights, immunities and appurtenances
 of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Charles Davis
 and to his heirs and assigns forever.
