To all to whom these presents shall come greeting:

Whereas Terry E. Davis of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the said office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Terry E. Davis ^{according} to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1870 entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto for the north half of the North West quarter of Section, two in Township forty North of range fourteen west of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing eighty acres according to the official plat of the Survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said Terry E. Davis. Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the acts of Congress in such case made and provided herein and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Terry E. Davis and his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of what ever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Terry E. Davis and his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I, Grover Cleveland, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed, Given under my hand at the City of Washington the twenty second day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty four and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and tenth.
