N^o 2089. Whereas Thomas A. Donahoe of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska when by it appears that full payment has been made by the said Thomas A. Donahoe according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto, for

the south-east quarter of Section Thirteen in Township Twelve North of Range Seventeen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said Thomas A. Donahoe.

Now know ye, that the United States of America in consideration of the promises and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such cases made and provided shall give and grant and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Thomas A. Donahoe and to his heirs the said tract above described; to have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges, immunities and appurtenances of what so ever nature therunto belonging unto the said Thomas A. Donahoe and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I Charles A. Arthur President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington the eleventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty four and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and ninth.
