Whereas, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island whereby it appears that, pursuant to the act of Congress, approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of William W. Pool has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the West half of the North-west Quarter of the North-east Quarter of Section six in Township eleven North of Range fourteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and fifty eight acres and fifty hundredths of an acre.

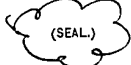
