Application 10038) To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting:
Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the register at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Acts of Congress approved 20th May 1862, to secure homes to actual settlers on the Public Domain, and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Henry Downer has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law for the north west quarter of section two in township nine north of range seventeen west of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing One Hundred and sixty acres and sixty nine hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General: Now know ye, that there is, thus far, granted by the United States unto the said Henry Downer the tract of land above described: to have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Henry Downer, and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the city of Washington the first day of March, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty six, and of the Independence of the United States one hundred and tenth.
