Certificate No 919 whereas William Eastredy of Nebraska according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 27 of April 1820 entitled an Act making further provisions for the sale of Public Land for the north half of the northeast quarter of section eight in Township 12 north of Range fourth west in the district of lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing 50 acres according to the official Plat of the survey of said lands returned to the General Land Office which tract has been purchased by the said Wm Eastredy

According to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General: the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the General Act of Congress the tract of land above described, to have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Wm Eastredy and to his heirs and assigns forever.

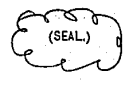
