Certificat No 2103

Whereas George Emminger of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appeared that full payment had been made by the said George Emminger according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24<sup>th</sup> of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto for the lot numbered three of section thirty first in Township Nine North of Range thirteen west of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing thirty three acres and fifty hundredths of an acre according to the Official plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said George Emminger. Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided have granted and do hereby grant unto the said George Emminger his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature thereunto belonging unto the said George Emminger his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the twentieth day of July in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and fourteenth
