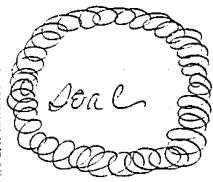
Certificate } To all, whom these presents shall come greeting:
 No. 651 } Whereas Jakob Enderly of Buffalo County Nebraska has
 deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate
 of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska, whereby
 it appears that full payment has been made by the said Jakob
 Enderly according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 20th
 of April 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale
 of Public Lands" for the north half of the north west quarter of Section
 Twenty in Township nine north Range fifteen west in the
 district of Lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska con-
 taining Eighty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey
 of said Lands, returned to the general Land Office by the
 Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by
 the said Jakob Enderly.

Now know ye, that the United States of America in consider-
 ation of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts
 of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and
 granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said
 Jakob Enderly and his heirs, the said tract above described;
 to have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges,
 immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto
 belonging, unto the said Jakob Enderly and his heirs
 and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I Wilkes S. Grant President of the Uni-
 ted States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent
 and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington the thirtieth
 day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and seventy three, and of the Independence of
 the United States the thirty eighth
