To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting;
Certificate No. 3441, Whereas Henry J. Evans of Buffalo
County Nebraska has deposited in the General
Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register
of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears
that full payment has been made by the said Henry J. Evans
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th
of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further provision for
the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto
for the South East quarter of Section Four in Township Eleven
North of Range Fifteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian
in Nebraska containing one hundred and fifty acres according
to the official Plat of the survey of the said lands returned to
the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said
tract has been purchased by the said Henry J. Evans. Now
known as, that the United States of America in consideration of
the promises and in conformity with the Survey acts of Congress
in such case made and provided have given and granted and
by these presents do give and grant unto the said Henry J.
Evans and his heirs the said tract above described, to have and
to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities
and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging unto
the said Henry J. Evans and his heirs and assigns forever. In
testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison, President of
the United States of America have caused these letters to
be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto
affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington
the twenty sixth day of September in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine and of the
Independence of the United States the one hundred and fourteenth.
