To all to whom these presents shall come greeting.
Certificate No 1692. — Whereas Nancie C. Knox of Buffalo County
Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the
United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office
at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full
payment has been made by the said Nancie C. Knox
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of
the 21st of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further
provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts
supplemental thereto for the South West quarter of Section
Nine in Township eight North of Range Fourteen West of
the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing
One Hundred and Sixty acres according to the Official
Plat of the Survey of the said lands returned to the
General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said
tract has been purchased by the said Nancie C. Knox
Now know ye that the United States of America in con-
sideration of the premises and in conformity with the several
Acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given
granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the
said Nancie C. Knox and to her heirs the said tract above
described to have and to hold the same together with all the
rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatever
nature thereunto belonging unto the said Nancie C. Knox
or her heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I
Chester A. Arthur President of the United States of
America have caused these letters to be made Patent and
the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed
Given under my hand at the City of Washington the
thirteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and eighty three and of the Independence of
the United States the one hundred and eighth
