To all whom these presents shall come greeting

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States
a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska,
whereby it appears that pursuant to the act of Congress approved 20th May,
1862, "To secure homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and
the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Philip Kenger has been
established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the lots
numbered five, six, seven and eight of Section eighteen in Township
eleven, North of Range sixteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in
Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty-one acres and eight-hundred-thre
acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said land
returned to the general Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now know ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto
the said Philip Kenger the tract of land above described: To have
and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereto unto
the said Philip Kenger and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I, Benjamin Garrison, President of the United
States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent and the Seal
of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
ninety, and of the Independence of the United States the one
hundred and fourteenth.

 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety three by and between
 The Minnesota Thresher Manufacturing Company, a corporation, organized
 acting and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of
 Minnesota with principal place of business at Stillwater County of
 Washington and State aforesaid, party of the first part and John Vacca
 of the County of Buffalo and State of Nebraska party of the second part.

Witnesseth. That said party of the first part for and in consideration
 of the sum of Nine hundred Dollars, lawful money of the United States to
 it in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged does hereby
 grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part
 all its right title and interest in and to that certain tract or parcel
 land situated in the County of Buffalo and State of Nebraska as described as
 follows: to wit, South West Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and North West Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
 of South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section Eleven, Township Eleventh (11)
 Range Fourteen U. S. I. West. To have and to hold the same together
 with all and singular the improvements hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto the said party
 of the second part his heirs and assigns forever. And the said party of
 the first part for itself its successors or assigns does hereby covenant
 promise and agree to and with the said party of the second part that
 it is lawfully seized of said premises and has good right to sell the
 same, and that it will warrant and forever defend the said descri-
 bed premises with the appurtenances thereto, against all lawful
 claims of all persons whomsoever.

 be hereunto subscribed and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed
 and these presents to be signed by its President and Secretary on the
 day and year first above written.
