Homestead Certificate No 8072
Application 3403 } Whereas, there has been deposited
in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate
of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska
whereby it appears that pursuant to the act of Congress
approved 20th May, 1862 "To secure Homesteads to actual
Settlers on the Public Domain" and the acts supplemental
thereto, the claim of William C. P. Kunth has been established
and duly consummated, in conformity to law for the north
west quarter of section thirty, in Township nine north of
Range seventeen west, in the District of lands subject
to sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing one
hundred and fifty six acres and ninety seven hundredths
of an acre according to the official plat of the Survey
of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office
by the Surveyor General;

Now know ye, that there is, therefore granted by
the United States unto the said William C. P. Kunth the
tract of Land above described; To have and the said
tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto
the said William C. P. Kunth and to his heirs and
assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, I Ulysses S. Grant President
of the United States of America, have caused these
letters to be made Patent; and the Seal of the General
Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
