Certificate No 10875 Whereas Michael Byrne of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Michael Byrne according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further provision for the Sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto for the North East Quarter of the North East Quarter of section twelve in Township twelve North of Range Thirteen West in the district of lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing forty acres according to the official Plat of the Survey of said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said Michael Byrne.

Now Know Ye That the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity to the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Michael Byrne and to his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all the rights franchises immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Michael Byrne and to his heirs and assigns forever

In testimony whereof I Rutherford B Hayes President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be affixed Given under my hand at the City of Washington the tenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy nine and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and fourth By the President R. B. Hayes
