Application 1993Whereas, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim ofIsaac Neff has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the South East Quarter of Section Twenty four, in Township Ten North of Range Sixteen, West in the District of Lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:Now Know Ye, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Isaac Neff the tract of Land above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Isaac Neff and to his heirs and assigns forever.In Testimony Whereof, I Rutherford B.
