To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:
Certificate, No. 1533. } Whereas, William Newell of Buffalo
County, Nebraska, has deposited in the General Land
Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the
Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it
appears that full payment has been made by the said
William Newell according to the provisions of the Act of
Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making
further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts
supplemental thereto, for the lot numbered three, four,
thirteen and fourteen of section six, in township eleven, north
of range sixteen west, of the sixth Principal Meridian
in Nebraska, containing one hundred and sixty four acres, and
forty eight hundredths of an acre, according to the official
Plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General
Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract
has been purchased by the said William Newell. Now know
ye, that the United States of America, in consideration
of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of
Congress in such case made and provided, have given and
granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the
said William Newell, and to his heirs, the said tract above
described; To have and to hold the same, together with all the
rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of
whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said
William Newell and to his heirs and assigns forever.
In Testimony Whereof, I Chester A. Arthur, President of
the United States of America have caused these letters to
be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office
to be hereunto affixed.

twenty fifth day of October in the year four thousand
thousand eight hundred and eighty four, and of the
Independence of the United States the one hundred
and ninth.
