The United States of America:
To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting:
Certificate No. 1791. Whereas William H. Mutter of Buffalo County, Nebraska,
has deposited in the general land office of the United States a Certificate of the
Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska whereby it appears that free
payment has been made by the said William H. Mutter according to the provisions of
the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision
for the sale of the public lands," and the act supplemental thereto, for the lot numbered
one of section eleven and the North Quarter of the North West Quarter and the lot numbered
two of section eight in Township Eight North of Range Fifteen West of the Sixth Principal
Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and seventy five acres and seventy three rods
more according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by
the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said William H. Mutter. Now know ye,
that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several
acts of Congress in such case made and provided, do give and grant, and by these presents
do give and grant, unto the said William H. Mutter and to his heirs, the said tract above described,
it have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurte-
nances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said William H. Mutter and to his
heirs and assigns forever. In Testimony Whereof, I, Chester A. Arthur, President of
the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the
seal of the General Land Office to be hereto affixed.
