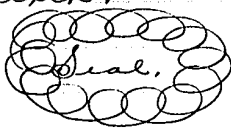

No. 1238 } To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Ester Reed of Buffalo County, Nebraska has de-
posited in the General Land Office of the United States
a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand
Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that full payment
has been made by the said Ester Reed according to
the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April
1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the
sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental ther-
to, for the lot numbered eight of Section ten, and the lot
numbered one of section fifteen, in township eight north,
of range fourteen west of the Sixth Principal Meridian
in Nebraska, containing seventy one acres and fifty
hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat
of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General
Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract
has been purchased by the said Ester Reed.

Now know ye, That the United States of America, in con-
sideration of the premises, and in conformity with the
several acts of congress in such case made and pro-
vided have given and granted, and by these presents do
give and grant unto the said Ester Reed and to her
heirs, the said tract above described; to have and to
hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges,
immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature
thereunto belonging, unto the said Ester Reed and to.
