To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:
Whereas, by virtue of the 3d Section of the act of Congress
approved January 28th, 1879, supplemental to the acts ap-
proved June 22d, 1860, March 2d, 1869 and June 10th 1872,
there has been deposited in the General Land Office
of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the
Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it
appears that Supreme Court Scrip No. 0. 150, Subdi-
vision — for 80 acres has been located by
Estes Reed and her claim thereby established
and duly consummated in conformity to law for the
Lot numbered two and the south east quarter of the
North west quarter of Section Fifteen, in Township Eight
North, of Range Fourteen west of the Sixth Principal Mer-
idian in Nebraska, containing eighty nine acres
and eighty hundredths of an acre. (Excess paid)
according to the official Plat of the survey of the said
