Whereas, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Saline, Nebraska, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the act of Congress, approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Miley Asher has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the second of the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24<sup>th</sup> of April 1820 entitled an act making further provisions for the sale of public lands and the acts supplemental thereto for the south half of the south west quarter of section twenty two in township seven north of Range sixteen west of the sixth principal meridian in Nebraska containing eighty acres according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Miley Asher the tract of land above described, to have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Miley Asher and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
