 No. 1684. To all whom these presents shall come, Greeting:
 Whereas, Henry W. Rizer of Buffalo County, Nebraska has deposited
 in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the
 Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it
 appears that Full Payment has been made by the said Henry W.
 Rizer according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th. of
 April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the
 sale of the Public Lands"; and the acts supplemental thereto, for
 the west half of the south east quarter of section twenty-two
 in township two north of range fifteen, west of the sixteenth
 Principal Meridian, in Nebraska, containing eighty acres,
 according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands,
 returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General,
 which said Tract has been purchased by the said Henry W. Rizer
 Now, know ye, That the United States of America, in considera-
 tion of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts
 of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and
 granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said
 Henry W. Rizer and to his heirs, the said Tract above described:
 To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights,
 privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever
 nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Henry W. Rizer and
 to his heirs and assigns forever. In Testimony whereof, I,
 Chester A. Arthur, President of the United States of America,
 have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the
 General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand,
 at the City of Washington, the eleventh day of October, in the year
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty four, and
 of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and
 ninth.
