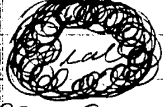

Timber Culture Certificate No 71. } Whereas there has been deposited in the
Application 445 } General Land Office of the United
States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island
Nebraska whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress
approved March 3, 1878, March 13, 1878, and June 14, 1878, To encourage
the growth of timber on the Western Prairies the claim of William
Rouch has been established and duly consummated in con-
formity to law for the South West Quarter of Section Twenty Four
in Township Ten, north of range Fourteen west of the sixth
Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing, containing One
Hundred and Sixty acres, according to the official plat of the survey
of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Sur-
veyor General, now known as, that there is therefore granted by
the United States unto the said William Rouch the tract of land
above described To have and to hold the said tract of land
with the appurtenances thereof unto the said William Rouch
and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I
Charles A. Arthur, President of the United States of America
have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the
General Land Office to be hereunto affixed Given under my
hand at the City of Washington the Fifth day of October in the
year of our Lord, one thousand, eight hundred & Eighty Three
