Application 440 } General Land Office of the United  
States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island  
Nebraska whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress  
approved March 3, 1873, on March 13, 1874, and June 14, 1878, to encourage  
the growth of timber on the Western Prairies the claim of William  
Roach has been established and duly pronounced in con-  
formity to law for the South West Quarter of Section Twenty-Two  
in Township Ten, north of Range Fourteen west of the sixth  
Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing, containing One  
hundred and sixty acres, according to the official plan of the survey  
of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Sur-  
veyor General. Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by  
the United States unto the said William Roach the tract of land
