TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME GREETING:

WHEREAS Joseph Robinson of Buffalo County, Nebraska has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grant Island, Nebraska whereby it appears that FULL PAYMENT has been made by the said Joseph Robinson <sup>according</sup> to the provisions of the Act of Congress on the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the Seal of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for

The East half of the North East quarter and the East half of the South East quarter of Section thirty two in Township twelve North of Range Seventeen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the Official Plate of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor General, which said Tract, has been purchased by the said Joseph Robinson.

Now Know Ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, Have Given and Granted, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Joseph Robinson and to his heirs, the said Tract above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Joseph Robinson and to his heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF I Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
