Do All to whom these presents shall come greeting:

Whereas Charles W. Dechaub of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that Full Payment has been made by the said Charles W. Dechaub according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto for the Lots numbered, namely, twenty, twenty one, and twenty two of Section Six in Township twelve North of Range Sixteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and fifty five acres of county one hundredths of an acre, according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Charles W. Dechaub.

Now I know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, Have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Charles W. Dechaub and to his heirs, the said tract above described. I Have had to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature therein belonging, unto the said Charles W. Dechaub and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof I Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
