Millholland, has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the tract half of the North west quarter and the west half of the South west quarter of section thirty-four in Township twelve, North of Range fifteen, West of the Principal Meridian in Nebraska, containing one hundred and one acres, according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:
