To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting.

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the acts of Congress approved March 3, 1873, March 13, 1874, and June 14, 1878 "To encourage the growth of timber on the Western Prairies," the claim of Johann Schmidt has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the South East quarter of Section two in Township eleven North Range fourteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now know ye, that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Johann Schmidt the tract of land above described, To have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereunto the said Johann Schmidt and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the city of Washington, the Twentieth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety two and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and seventeenth.

Know all men by these presents, that Johann Schmidt and Fiederike Schmidt, his wife of the County of Buffalo and State of Nebraska for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, in hand paid do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto August Weidner of the County of Buffalo and State of Nebraska the following described real estate situated in Buffalo County and State of Nebraska to wit:

The South East quarter of Section two (2) in Township eleven (11) North, Range fourteen (14) West of the 6th Principal Meridian, containing 160 acres, and we do hereby covenant with the said August Weidner and his heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized of said premises; that they are free

from insurance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the title to said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. And the said Friederike Schmidt, hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises.

Articles of agreement, made this Eightieth day of September in the year
of our Lord, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety three between John
Fisher & Martha J. Fisher, husband & wife, party of the first part, and William
F. Ford party of the second part, witnesseth: That said party of the first part
hereby covenants and agrees that if the party of the second part shall just
make the payment and perform the covenants hereinafter mentioned on
his part to be made and performed, the said party of the first part will
convey and assure to the party of the second part, in fee simple, clear of all
incumbrances whatever, by good and sufficient warranty deed, the
following lot, piece or parcel of ground, viz:
The North East quarter of Section one, in Town Twelve, Range sixteen West of
the 6 P.M., containing one hundred & sixty two acres. Said land is
situated in Buffalo County, Nebraska.

And the said party of the second part hereby covenants and agrees to pay
to said party of the first part the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars, in the
manner following, payable February 1st, 1898, Dollars each in hand
paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the balance - with
interest at the rate of Six per centum per annum, payable February 1st.
