Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862 "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the Public Domain", and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Engelbert Schwab has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the West Half of the North West quarter and the West half of the South West quarter of Section five in Township Two North of Range

seventeen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty-two acres and twenty hundredths of an acre according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.
