County, Nebraska has deposited in the general land office
of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land
Office at Grand Island, Nebraska whereby it appears that
full payment has been made by the said Mathew Schwasinger
according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of
April 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the
sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto, for
the North West Quarter of Section Eight, in Township Eleven
North of Range Fifteen west of the Sixth Principal Meridian, in
Nebraska, containing one hundred and sixty acres according
to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the
general land office by the Surveyor General, which said tract
