In Testimony whereof, I Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the nineteenth day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and thirtieth.
