

Certificate No. 1348.

The United States of America, To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting:

Whereas Jens Segard of Buffalo County, Nebraska, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Jens Segard, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1829, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands", and the acts supplemental thereto, for the Lot numbered five, six, ten and eleven of Section nine, in Township eight north, of Range seventeen west of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska, containing one hundred and fifty acres and thirty five hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Jens Segard.

Now, know ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Jens Segard and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I Chester A. Arthur, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the sixth day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and sixth.
