Presentments shall come, greeting: To certificate no 271. Whereas
Martin Slattery, of Buffalo County, Nebraska, has deposited
in the General Land office of the United States, a certificate
of the Register of the Land office at Grand Island ne-
braska, whereby it appears that full payment has been
made by the said Martin Slattery, according to the pro-
visions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820.
entitled "An Act making further provisions for the
sale of the Public Lands," for the north west Quarter of
the North West Quarter of Section Five, in Township Nine,
north of Range thirteen west, in the district of lands
subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska, containing
forty acres, according to the Official Plat of the
Survey of the ^{said} Lands, returned to the General Land office
by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been
purchased by the said Martin Slattery. Now. Know
ye. That the United States of America, in consideration
of the premises, and in conformity with the several
Acts of Congress in such case made and provided,
Have Given and Granted, and by these presents do give
and grant, unto the said Martin Slattery, and to his
heirs: the said tract above described. To have and to
hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges,
immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever
nature, therunto belonging, unto the said Martin
Slattery, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Ulysses S. Grant, Pres-
ident of the United States, of America, have caused
these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the
General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
