

The United States of America. To all, to whom these presents shall come: Greeting. Certificate No 892. Whereas Wilson Slovi of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Wilson Slovi according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled an act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands, for the west half of the South East Quarter of Section Twenty two in Township Nine North, of Range Sixteen west in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at Grand Island Nebraska. Containing eighty acres according to the official plat of the Survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said Wilson Slovi.

Now Know Ye, that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Wilson Slovi and to his heirs the said tract above described, to have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Wilson Slovi, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof I Ulysses S. Grant President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed, given under my hand at the City of Washington the fifth day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy four and of the independence of the United States the Ninety Ninth.
