Certificate No. 631. The United States of America
 To all to whom these presents shall come greeting:
 Whereas Mary Ann Smith, of Buffalo county, Nebraska,
 has deposited in the General Land Office of the United
 States a certificate of the Register of the land office at
 Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that full
 payment has been made by the said Mary Ann
 Smith according to the provisions of the act of Congress
 of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "an act making further
 provision for the sale of the public lands of the Public
 Lands" for the North half of the North West quarter of
 section Twenty-two in Township Nine North of Range
 fifteen West in the district of lands subject to sale
 at Grand Island, Nebraska, containing Eighty acres
 according to the official plan of the survey of said
 lands returned to the General Land Office by the
 Surveyor General; which said tract has been purchased
 by the said Mary Ann Smith. Now know ye that the
 United States of America in consideration of the premises
 and in conformity with the several acts of congress in
 such case made and provided have given and
 granted and by these presents do give and grant
 unto the said Mary Ann Smith and to her heirs
 the said tract above described; to have and to
 hold the same together with all the rights, privileges,
 immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature
 therunto belonging unto the said Mary Ann Smith
 and to her heirs and assigns forever.
 In testimony whereof I Ulysses S. Grant - President of
 the United States of America have caused these
 letters to be made patent and the Seal of the
 General Land Office to be hereunto affixed
 given under my hand at the City of Washington
 the second day of June in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight-hundred and seventy-three
 and of the independence of the United States the Ninety-
 seventh
