Lovins & Lauretta Lovins husband & wife of the county of Arapahoe and State of Colorado, of the first part and Robert E. French of the county of Buffalo and State of Nebraska of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty Dollars - to the said parties of the first part in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed, and acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all the following described lot - or parcel - of land situate, lying and being in the county of Buffalo State of Nebraska. To wit: Lot number eight (8) in Block number One (1) in the Kearney Land & Investment company's (since) addition to Kearney Buffalo county Nebraska. Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging, as is any wise appertaining and the reversions and reversions, remainders and remainders rents, issues and profits thereof, and all the estate, right, title interest, claim and demand whatsoever of the said parties of the first part either in law or equity of, in and to the above bargained premises, with the hereditaments and appurtenances, to have and to hold the said premises above bargained and described, with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.
