Simpson of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Robert L. Simpson according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24<sup>th</sup> of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto for the north west quarter of Section thirty two in Township nine north of range fifteen west of the sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and fifty six acres and ninety nine hundredths of an acre according to the Official Plan of the Survey of the lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said Robert L. Simpson

Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Robert L. Simpson and to his heirs the said tract above described so far as to have the same together with all the rights privileges immunitie and appurtenances of whatsoever nature therewith belonging unto the said Robert L.
