Do all to whom these presents shall come greeting:

Whereas John Stutz of Buffalo County, Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John Stutz according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled 'An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands' and the acts supplemental thereto for the South East quarter of Section three in Township eight North of Range thirteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and fifty nine acres and eighty hundredths of an acre according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said John Stutz. Now know Ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such cases made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John Stutz and to his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances whatsoever nature therein belonging unto the said John Stutz and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I Chester A Arthur President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed Given under my hand at the City of Washington the twelfth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty two and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and sixth
