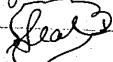

To all to whom these presents shall come greeting:

Whereas Sobeski Thompson of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Sobeski Thompson according to the provisions of an act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the North East Quarter of Section Twenty Four in Township Nine North of Range Seventeen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing One hundred and sixty acres according to the official plat of the Survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Sobeski Thompson Now Know Ye, that the United States of America in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the General Acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Sobeski Thompson and to her heirs, the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging unto the said Sobeski Thompson and to her heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, I Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed Given under my hand at the City of Washington the Twelfth day of December in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and Ninety four and of the Independence of the United States the One hundred and Nineteenth
