Certificate } Whereas Eunice V Towers of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited
No 5681 } in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of
the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has been
made by the said Eunice V. Towers, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of
the 24th of April 1820 entitled "An Act vesting further provisions for the Sale of the
Public Lands," and the acts Supplemental thereto, for the North half of the
North East Quarter of Section Eleven and the lot Humboldt four of section
Twelve in Township eight North of Range fourteen West of the Sixth Prin-
cipal Meridian in Nebraska containing One hundred and fourteen acres,
according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land
Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said
Eunice V. Towers.

Now Know ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the
premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case
made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and
grant, unto the said Eunice V. Towers and to her heirs, the said Tract above described;

To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges immu-
nities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thence to belonging, unto
the said Eunice V. Towers, and to her heirs and assigns forever.
