#### **Approval of Minutes-**

After discussion it was moved by Harpst and seconded by Mitchell to approve the amount of \$3,100.00 Rent, Groceries and Medical. Upon vote, the motion passed unanimously.

Veteran's Service Officer Starkey presented an update from the Veterans Service Office about the open application process for hiring an additional Veteran Service Officer. Discussion occurred.
